Summer 2018 Rates & Information



Tuition

A weekly tuition of \$175 per student includes most field trips and activities scheduled for each week. Parents will be notified in advance of any additional costs.

Weekly tuition is due by Friday for the upcoming week and cannot be pro-rated. After School Plus accepts payments by check, credit/debit card and bank draft. All payments are due/processed on Friday for the upcoming week. Checks should be placed in the secured box outside the ASP office. All families must have a credit card on file.

Any changes in the week's attendance must be made in writing at least 14 days prior to the start of the week being changed.

Deposits and Discounts:

A non-refundable deposit of \$20 per week is due at the time of enrollment. Additional siblings are \$15 per week.

Discounts

- Sibling – additional campers receive a 5% discount on tuition.
- Paid In Full – families paying summer tuition in full before June 8th will receive a 5% discount on tuition.

Extracurricular Activities:

Families have the opportunity to choose from additional activities on and off-site!

- Music lessons in piano & guitar. 30 minute lesson is \$20.
- Tutoring in all subjects. 60 minute lesson is \$40.
- Beginner Swim lessons, small group. ASP provides transportation to/from local pool. \$90 for 6 weeks/lessons.
- On-site gymnastics classes with Greenville Gymnastics. Visit their website for a complete list of classes and pricing.
- On-site dance classes with DanceArts. Visit their website for a complete list of classes and pricing.

Hours:

We are open Monday through Friday from 7:30 am until 6 pm. A late fee of \$10 will be collected when a child is picked up after 6:15 pm. Cash or check payment is expected at the time of pick-up. Students participating in DAG or GG classes after 6:00 must make arrangements with ASP and DAG/Greenville Gymnastics.

Holidays:

After School Plus will be closed on Wednesday July 4th. Tuition is not pro-rated.

Sign-in & Sign:

Parents are asked to sign their children in and out daily on the attendance sheets posted at the front desk. After School Plus parents should not stop or park in the pick-up/drop-off lane.

Lunch & Snacks:

Our lunch time runs from 10:15-12:30 pm. Children should bring a bag lunch and drink each day. Please label lunch boxes and water bottles. One snack is provided each day. Additional snacks can be purchased from vending machines in our café. Snacks include popcorn, ice-cream, fruit, granola bars, chips, etc. Students have access to a microwave and refrigerator on-site. Water is always available to children. Pizza will be available on Fridays for \$1.00 per slice (cash only). Pizza must be ordered in advance.

Medications:

All prescription and over the counter medications must be in the original container. Medications must be stored in the office and administered by staff. Parents must complete our "Medicine Authorization Form". Medications will be taken off-site on field trips as needed.

Field Trips:

Field trips and activities are posted by Thursday for the following week. Information is posted on our Facebook page, emailed and in the facility. Please take note of departure and return times. If your child is unable to participate in a field trip he/she will be placed with a younger group and remain on-site.

While riding on buses campers are expected to adhere to the following rules;

- Eating and drinking are not permitted (except water)
- Sit two to a seat and wear seat belts
- Hands, arms, objects must remain inside the bus at all times
- Do not distract the driver with excessively loud voices or noise
- Bus drivers and ASP staff must be obeyed. Drivers and staff reserve the right to assign seats or other disciplinary actions to ensure the safety of riders.

What to Bring & Wear:

Please make sure that your child wears shoes appropriate for the scheduled activities, uses lots of sunscreen and brings a water bottle. A change of clothes is recommended for younger children. Please make sure that all clothing is clearly marked with your child's name.

What NOT to bring & wear:

Any item that interferes with classes will be confiscated and returned to the parents at the end of the day. All communication between campers and families should be done through the office and ASP staff.

- Toys, games or stuffed animals
- Cell phones and other electronic devices/games
- Sandals/Open toed shoes
- Jewelry & valuable items

Behavior:

After School Plus believes that discipline issues are best dealt with using positive behavior methods including redirection, time-outs, 1-1 counseling and incident reports. Campers are expected to exhibit respect for self, others, teachers and the facility. If there is a situation regarding misbehavior, and the above procedures have not been effective, staff will -

- First offense – child completes incident report; parent may be notified
- Second offense – Child removed for the activity; parent notified in writing
- Third offense – Parent conference and/or suspension
- Fourth offense – Parent conference and/or removal from program.
